

**2013 Dana Estates Cabernet Sauvignon Helms Vineyard, Rutherford**

Unique aromas of citrus fruit such as tangerines and oranges with plum, black cherry, and black currants. Lemon rind too. Full-bodied with ultra-fine tannins that give the wine a precise and focused finish that lasts for minutes. It really is laser-guided. Savory and subtle, minerally finish. This redefines the greatness of Napa Valley wine and California.

**100****2013 Dana Estates Cabernet Sauvignon Lotus Vineyard, Napa Valley**

Here is a perfect wine with incredible aromatics showing lilacs, violets and roses. Slate, blueberry and blackberry undertones. Full-bodied, powerful and intense. Blueberry and hot stones. Incredible depth and intensity. This needs at least three to five years to come together. The mountain fruit delivers such structure and richness.

**99****2013 Dana Estates Cabernet Sauvignon Hershey Vineyard, Howell Mountain**

The aromas of tar, slate, and graphite with dark fruits such as blackberries are so prevalent here. Licorice too. Smoked meat. Full-bodied, very layered, dense and profound. Mouth-filling and structured. A wine that is fascinating now but even better in 2020.

**98****2013 Dana Estates Cabernet Sauvignon Onda, Napa Valley**

This is the best Onda ever. Subtle and perfumed aromas of blackberry, sage, and bramble berry. Plummy. Full-bodied, chewy yet velvety and polished. Layered and delicious. Pretty balance and length. Savory and salty. White pepper too. Wonderful finish. A blend of wines from all the vineyards of Dana with a majority from Crystal Springs and Hershey. So much precision here. Drink or hold.
